4 QR GRAMMAR AND CREATIVE WRITING-3

- **STEP I:** Download and install the 'Allern Active' App from Google Play Store (for android users) or Apple App Store (for IOS users).
- **STEP II:** Complete Registration.
- **STEP III:** Tap on activate a new workbook, on the Home page of the App and follow the instructions on the screen.

Scan any QR code of any chapter from inside the book you have purchased and want to activate.

STEP IV: App will display the Grade and Subject of the book.



SCIENCE

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: Model of Heartbeat Hero (Stethoscope)

Objective: This simple project helps students understand the basic mechanics of a stethoscope and introduces them to fundamental concepts in anatomy and sound transmission.

Materials Needed

- Plastic tubing (about 2-3 feet long)
- A small plastic funnel (or two if you want a more realistic look)
- A balloon
- Scissors
- o Tape
- A cardboard or plastic cup (optional, for a diaphragm)



Steps to Make the Stethoscope

Step 1: Prepare the Earpieces

- 1. **Cut the Tubing**: Cut the plastic tubing into two equal pieces, each about 1-1.5 feet long.
- 2. Attach the Funnels: If you are using funnels for the earpieces, insert the narrow end of each funnel into one end of each tubing piece. Secure them with tape to ensure there are no air leaks. These will be your earpieces.



Step 2: Make the Chest Piece

3. **Prepare the Diaphragm**: Cut the top part of the balloon to create a flat, stretched piece of rubber. This will act as the diaphragm of your stethoscope.

4. Attach the Diaphragm: Stretch the balloon piece over the wide end of the funnel (or cup if you are using one). Secure it tightly with tape or a rubber band. Ensure it is stretched tight and flat.



Step 3: Assemble the Stethoscope

5. **Join the Tubing**: Insert the open ends of the two pieces of tubing into the wide end of the funnel (or cup). Use tape to secure them firmly in place. If you are using two funnels, connect them at the wide ends and then attach the tubing to each.



Step 4: Test the Stethoscope

Testing: Place the diaphragm (balloon-stretched part) on your chest or another person's chest. Put the earpieces (funnels) in your ears. You should be able to hear the heartbeat.
