QR GRAMMAR AND CREATIVE WRITING-4

STEP I: Download and install the ‘Allern Active’ App from Google Play Store (for android users) or Apple App Store (for IOS users).

STEP II: Complete Registration.

STEP III: Tap on activate a new workbook, on the Home page of the App and follow the instructions on the screen.

Scan any QR code of any chapter from inside the book you have purchased and want to activate.

STEP IV: App will display the Grade and Subject of the book.

Continue further by tapping ‘Proceed’ or ‘Cancel’.

STEP V: Scratch the sticker available on the book’s cover page to reveal the Unique Activation Code (UAC).

Enter the UAC in the text field correctly. Please note the code is case sensitive.

SCIENCE

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: Nature Scavenger Hunt

Objective: Identify different types of plants and plant parts in nature.

Materials:

- Scavenger hunt checklist (on A4 sheet)
- Pencil
- Clipboard

Activity Steps:

1. Create a checklist of items to find, such as a type of leaf, flower, fruit, seed, tree bark, etc.
2. Children can go to a park or garden.
3. Parents can encourage them to explore and check off the items they find.
4. Discuss each item and its role in the plant's life cycle.

EXPERIMENT: Spoily Oily

Objective:

This activity not only teaches about the presence of fat in food but also encourages observational skills and critical thinking.

Material needed:

- Brown paper bags or white paper
- Various food samples (such as nuts, cheese, potato chips, butter, apple slice, cucumber, bread)
- Paper towels
- Pencils and notepads for observations
- Labels for each food sample
- Hand sanitizer for clean-up

Steps:

Preparation:

- Cut the brown paper bags into small squares (about 4×4 inches) or use white paper squares. Each student will need one square paper per food sample.
- Prepare and label the different food samples. Ensure you have a mix of fatty and non-fatty foods.

Activity Instructions:

- Take a set of paper squares and a pencil.
- Label each paper square with the name of the food sample you will be testing.

Testing for Fat:

- Place a small piece of each food sample on the corresponding labelled paper square.
- Gently press the food onto the paper for a few seconds.
- After pressing, you should remove the food and observe the paper.

Discussion:

- Once all the tests are done, discuss your findings with your parents or siblings. Which foods left greasy spots? Which did not?
- Talk about why certain foods left greasy spots and what that indicates about their fat content.
- Discuss the importance of having a balanced diet, including healthy fats.
