

SCIENCE

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: Mini Ecosystem in a Jar

Materials Needed:

- Clear glass or plastic jars with lids
- Small pebbles or gravel
- Activated charcoal
- Potting soil
- Small plants or moss
- Water
- Optional: small decorative items like tiny figurines or natural objects (e.g., small sticks, leaves)
- Labels and markers

Steps:

1. Layering the Jar:

- Start by adding a layer of small pebbles or gravel to the bottom of the jar for drainage.
- Add a thin layer of activated charcoal to help filter the water and keep the ecosystem fresh.
- Add a layer of potting soil on top of the charcoal. This will be the base for the plants.



2. Planting :

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- Choose small plants or moss to add to your jar. Think about how plants will interact and where to place them.
- Gently plant the chosen greenery into the soil, ensuring roots are covered.
- Add small decorative items to personalize your ecosystem.



3. Watering:

• Add a small amount of water to jar. The soil should be damp but not waterlogged.

4. Sealing and Observation:

- Seal the jars with lids.
- Label the jars with your name and the date.

5. Discussion and Journaling:

- Discuss with your family members what your expect to see over the next few days and weeks.
- Make a record of your observations, note changes in plant growth, condensation on the jar, etc.

6. Follow-up:

- Set aside a few minutes each day or week to observe and note changes in the jar.
- Have periodic discussions about your observations and what you are learning about ecosystem.

OBJECTIVE: This hands-on activity is not only educational but also fosters a sense of responsibility and curiosity about the natural world.

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: Seed Germination Experiment

Materials Needed:

- Clear plastic cups or small pots
- Cotton balls or paper towels
- Various seeds (e.g., beans, sunflower, peas)
- Water
- Permanent markers
- Ruler
- Journals for recording observations

Steps:

1. Setting Up the Experiment:

- Place a layer of cotton balls or a folded paper towel inside each cup.
- Moisten the cotton balls or paper towel with water, making sure they are damp but not soaked.
- Place a few seeds on top of the cotton or paper towel, ensuring they are spaced out and can be easily observed.

2. Observation and Recording:

- Place your cup in a warm, well-lit area but not in direct sunlight.
- Each day, check your seeds and ensure the cotton or paper towel remains moist.
- You should measure any growth with a ruler and record observations in your journals. You can note changes in the seed size, shape, color, and the appearance of roots and shoots.

3. Discussion and Analysis:

- After about a week, discuss your observations with your family and parents like:
 - What changes did you observe in your seeds over the week?
 - Did all the seeds germinate at the same rate? Why do you think that is?
 - What do you think the seeds need to grow into healthy plants?
 - How did the different types of seeds compare in terms of germination time and growth?

4. **Objective:**

To observe and understand the process of seed germination.
